## Begin the Spring Semester with these new resources!



ECCO provides access to the digital images of every page of 150,000 books published between 1700 and 1799. With full-text searching of approximately 26 million pages, it gives researchers access to critical information in the fields of history, literature, religion, law, fine arts, science and more. The majority of works in ECCO are in the English language but there are also works printed in Dutch, French, German, Italian, Latin, Spanish and Welsh.



McGraw-Hill Encyclopedia of Science and Technology (the web site is called Access Science) is the most trusted and authoritative general science encyclopedia. It contains thousands of articles, 2,000 biographies, current bibliographies, and 110,000 definitions.



Directed primarily at academic researchers, *Academic OneFile* is a collection of more than 8,000 journals with full manual indexing, a robust backfile and coverage of a variety of academic disciplines -- from science, technology and medicine to the humanities. With the majority of the content peer-reviewed and available in full-text with no restrictions, users are able to access content quickly and conduct comprehensive research effortlessly.
