**Photocopiers** - Coin-operated photocopiers are located on each floor. A bill-changer is on the 2nd floor.

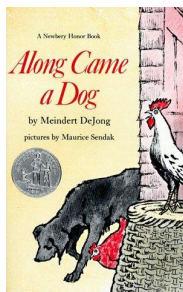
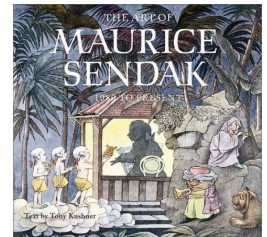

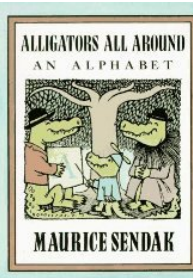
